

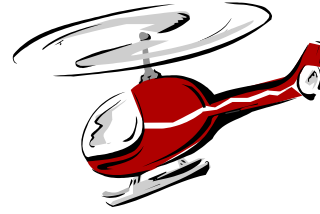

A Special meeting at the LARKS West Flying Field called to order at 9:45 am by Walt Senour.

Mel Barrington was recognized by Walt as a visitor.

The minutes of the 20 February 2020 meeting were read and approved. The checking account balance was read.

SAFETY & FIELD REPORT:

Walt reported that Field chemicals have been purchased but that they will not be put out until the field has dried out. Wayne York reported that a hand launch of a pusher aircraft resulted in prop cuts to the hand. Aid was provided after the incident. Do NOT fly alone.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. The LARKS Budget for 2020 and 2021 was discussed. Cost cutting methods were discussed.
2. The condition and status of the lawn mower was discussed.
3. Because all meetings after February have been canceled due to the Corona Virus, a motion was made, seconded and passed to hold future monthly meetings at either of the flying fields on a Saturday as decided by the board.
4. The donations of prizes for the April raffle aircraft will be held until the next event.
5. The Steve Fogle Memorial Float Fly at Neeces will be on 11 September 2020.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. The status of the LARKS 501 C-3 was discussed. LARKS is not holding large events or making donations to charities, and because the process of submitting annual registrations as well as detailed financial reports is time consuming and burdensome, a motion was made, seconded, and passed to cancel our 501 C-3 status with the Secretary of State.
2. Members were asked to consider the election of officers for 2021.
3. AMA recognition pins were presented to the 2020 LARKS officers.
4. There is no new information regarding the FAA/AMA status.
